36 semester hrs / 12 courses

CORE COURSES (18 SEMESTER HRS / 6 COURSES)

Students must take 6 core courses:

- » Analytics II

- » Intelligence Operations

MAJOR COURSES (12 SEMESTER HRS / 4 COURSES)

Students must select 4 courses from a list of 33 courses based upon their concentration. Major courses include:

- » Counterintelligence
- » Cyber Intelligence
- » Ethical Challenges in the Intelligence Community
- » Terrorism: Assessing the Past to Forecast the Future

In addition to a general concentration, concentrations are offered in:

Criminal Intelligence, Cyber, Homeland Security, Intelligence Analysis, Intelligence Collection, Intelligence Management, Intelligence Operations, and Terrorism Studies.
