BACHELOR OF ARTS IN MILITARY HISTORY

121 semester hrs / 40 courses

GENERAL EDUCATION (37 SEMESTER HRS / 12 COURSES)

Requirements include foundations of online learning, English, history, literature and humanities, science and mathematics, political science, and social sciences.

CORE COURSES (21 SEMESTER HRS / 7 COURSES)

Students must take 7 core courses:

- » Research Methods in History
- » Introduction to Military History
- » War from Antiquity to 1700
- » War from 1700 to the Present
- » Survey of American Military History
- » Readings in Military Leadership
- » Readings in Military Philosophy

MAJOR COURSES (33 SEMESTER HRS / 11 COURSES)

Students must select 11 courses in a concentration area.

Courses Include:

- » Medieval Military History
- » Antebellum America
- » The Korean War

In addition to a general concentration, a concentration is offered in **American Military History**.


ELECTIVES (27 SEMESTER HRS / 9 COURSES)

36 semester hrs / 12 courses

CORE COURSES (12 SEMESTER HRS / 4 COURSES)

Students must take 4 core courses:

- » Historical Research Methods
- » Historiography
- » Writing a Thesis Proposal
- » Great Military Philosophers

MAJOR COURSES (18 SEMESTER HRS / 6 COURSES)

Students must select 6 major courses based upon their concentration. Concentrations are offered in:

- » American Revolution
- » American Military History
- » Civil War
- » World War II
- » War Since 1945
- » Military and Diplomatic History

Major courses include:

- » American Military and Diplomatic History
- » The American Revolution in Context
- » Antebellum America: Prelude to the Civil War
- » The War in Vietnam
- » Nazi Germany and the Holocaust
- » The Cold War Era and Aftermath
- » World War II in Context
