In addition to specialized homeland security courses, these interdisciplinary programs draw from emergency management, political science, intelligence, public administration, public health, security management, and transportation and logistics management curriculum. This integrated learning approach is designed to prepare professionals to be at the forefront of national and local homeland security initiatives.
