CHECKLIST: FIRST RESPONSE TO A METH LAB SCENE

- 1. Wear proper safety equipment before entering area.
- 2. Approach the area from upwind.
- Secure the location, and notify on-scene emergency medical, fire, and hazmat personnel.
- 4. Do not smoke in or around the area.
- Ensure any persons in the area are removed to a safe location. Consider evacuation, if appropriate.
- 6. Administer emergency first aid, if necessary.
- Do not touch, taste, or smell equipment, chemicals, or containers without proper safety equipment.
- 8. Do not trust container labels, as contents may have been switched.
- 9. Do not attempt to curtail or stop any observed chemical reaction.
- Do not turn any electrical devices or lights on or off, including flashlights.
 Do not unplug any electrical devices.
- 11. Do not turn off the water supply to the structure or the chemical reaction.
- Avoid contamination of yourself, suspects, and bystanders when removing contaminated clothing, shoes, and equipment.
- If executing a raid, ensure emergency medical assistance is on-scene prior to execution.
